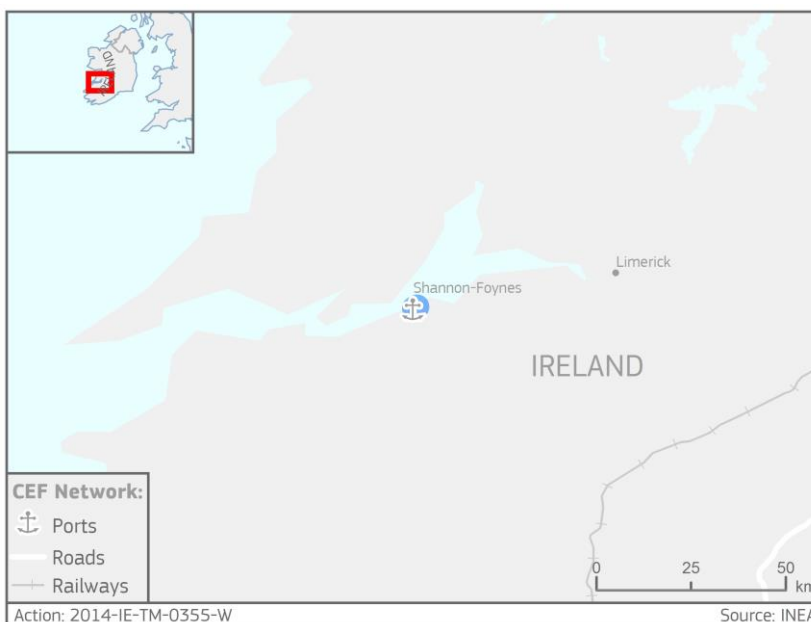

Jetty Enhancement for Sea Port Infrastructure Connectivity (JESPIC)

The Action is located in the Republic of Ireland in the Core maritime Port of Shannon Foynes. It aims at expanding the East Jetty to improve loading and turnaround times on the jetty by 2016. This will increase the capacity and efficiency of the services offered by the Port.

The completion of the Action is key to the implementation of the Global Project "Vision 2041". It removes a bottleneck for transport and freight handling. The Action consists mainly of preliminary and ground works, sheet and combi pile wall construction and provision of the second access point, diversion of services, pipework and ancillary works.

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
