## Creating a network of connected safe and secure parking areas in Hungary and Romania (SecureNetwork)

2019-EU-TMC-0323-W



The Action covers:

- The construction of one new "gold" level standard Safe and Secure Trucks Parking Area (SSTPA) with 170 parking spaces at Kiskunfelegyhaza on the Hungarian motorway M5;
- The construction of one new "gold" level standard SSTPA with 180 parking spaces at Curtici in the proximity of the Romanian motorway E 671;
- The upgrading of one existing SSTPA at Nagykanizsa on the Hungarian motorway M7 with 35 parking spaces at "bronze" level standard, and
- The upgrading of one existing SSTPA at Hatvan on the Hungarian motorway M3 with 80 parking spaces at "silver" level standard.

The SSTPAs will be accessible from both sides of the respective motorways. In addition, they will be digitally connected to the National Access Points. The Action is part of a Global Project that aims to address the current lack of SSTPAs by building or upgrading a total of 141 SSTPAs in Europe by 2026.

It consists of four activities:

- Project Management and other services
- Construction of a new SSTPA in Hungary
- Construction of a new SSTPA in Romania
- Upgrade of two existing SSTPAs in Hungary

The Action is expected to enhance road transport safety and security as well as to reduce congestion on the road network of Hungary and northern Romania.
