Setting up the first safe and secure truck parking area in Southern Hungary

The Action covers the construction of a new Safe and Secure Truck Parking Areas (SSTPA) with 131 parking spaces for Heavy Good Vehicles (HGV) on the Hungarian M5 motorway (E75) north of Szeged and in close proximity of the city of Balástya. The SSTPA will be accessible from both sides of the motorway and it will comply with the “gold” level EU-Parking Standard for security. In addition, it will be digitally connected to the National Access Point. The Action is part of a Global Project that aims to reduce the current deficit of parking spaces for heavy goods vehicles (HGV) along the road sections of the Orient/East-Med and the Rhine-Danube corridors located in the southern Hungarian region of Dél-Alföld.

It consists of three activities:

- Project Management and Other Services
- Construction of the SSTPA
- Security and ITS services

The Action is expected to enhance road transport safety and security as well as to reduce congestion on the road network of southern Hungary.
